The Angel of the North by Antony Gormley is located in Gateshead close to the A1. It was completed in 1998 and is a "must see" for your itinary

This imposing metal sculpture at Seaham Harbour, entitled 1101, owing to the fact the armistice went into effect at 11am on November 11, 1918, stands 9ft 5ins tall and weighs 1.2 tonnes. Created by Ray Lonsdale, the sculpture is known locally as "Tommy"
